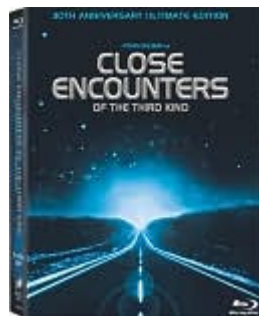

Movie Night at the Ames Free Library hosted by yours truly. Hope to see you there! This month we will be showing "The Conspirator".



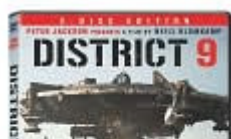

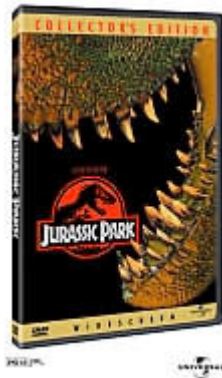
