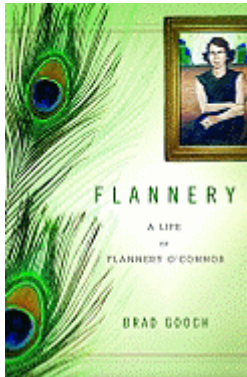

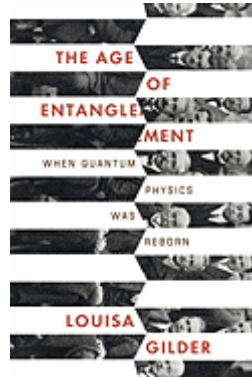

This award-winning biographer sketches an elegant and powerfully illuminating picture of the fierce and darkly funny iconic writer, Flannery O'Connor.

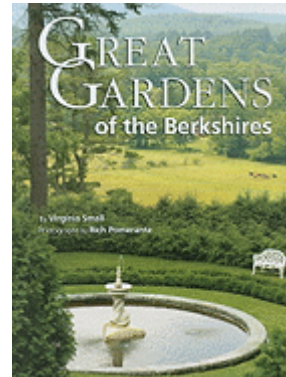

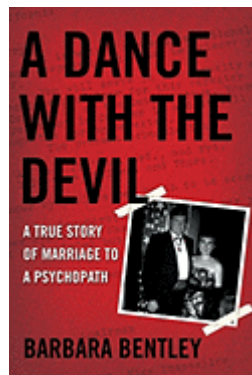
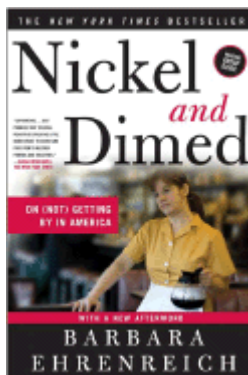
