# 1. Search the catalog

To see what you can download for your Kindle, visit our OverDrive library at [sails.overdrive.com](https://sails.overdrive.com).

Looking for a specific title, author, or keyword? Click on the "Search" icon on the upper right hand side of the page.

Then click the "Advanced" link that appears on the lower right of the search bar.

On the "Advanced" page, use the "Format" index to select "Kindle Book" and then also type your search terms in the appropriate fields. Click on the blue "Search" button at the bottom of the page.

Want to browse? Click on "Kindle Books" in the top menu. You can then narrow your results by using the filter options on the left hand side of the page.

# 2. Check out an eBook

Once you have located a Kindle Book title, you will see one of two things at the bottom of each item: "Borrow" or "Place a hold." Clicking on either link will prompt you to sign in. (If a title has no available copies, you may place a hold and an email will be sent when the title is available.)

On the sign-in screen, choose "SAILS library patrons," enter your library card number and PIN (usually the last four digits of your phone number). Click "Sign in."

Choose a lending period for the title, then click the blue "Borrow" button.

# 3. Transfer & Read!

Select the "Read now with Kindle" button. You will be taken to Amazon.com to finish getting the eBook. If you're not already signed in to Amazon, click the yellow "Get Library Book" button to sign in with your Amazon credentials. If already signed in, verify which device to send the book to, and click the "Get Library Book" button.

Connect your Kindle to wi-fi to sync and download!



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
